Certificate in Well Control and Blowout Prevention (BOP)

This course is fully accredited by the IADC Well Control Accreditation Program - WellCAP, IWCF and the combined IADC/IWCF International Alliance for Well Control (IAWC).

The course curriculum addresses three levels of well control responsibility appropriate to a Surface Stack or Combined Surface or Subsea operation:

Supervisory level

(advanced driller, toolpushers, superintendent and engineer)

Introductory level

(derrick hands and oilfield support personnel)

Fundamental/ Driller level

(trainee driller and driller)

The course content covers:

- > Causes of kicks
- > Kick prevention
- > Pressure concepts and calculations
- > Procedures for flow checks, shut-in and other activities
- > Gas characteristics and behavior
- > Fluid types and properties
- > Constant bottom hole pressure methods
- > Instrumentation and equipment
- > Subsea well control and equipment
- > Operations instruction in special situations such as H2S or shallow gas.

Course Location and Dates:

Course duration is five days and operates under IADC and IWCF guidelines on instructional content, length of study for various topics, test construction, class size and simulator/test well exercises.
